

You will be following an Itinerary, or a plan for a journey. You will be traveling around New York. Read through the lesson and then open and save the work file.

A cub reporter is often paired with a seasoned veteran. You have just learned that you will be according to the human interest story about a group of students attending an important function at the United Nations Headquarters in New York City. Take a few minutes to view a copy of the group's itinerary.



Your job is to create a written list of driving directions to get you and your partner to each location. There are two ways of finding a location. One is to use absolute location. However, finding latitude and longitude coordinates is not going to help you on this assignment. You need to find relative location. That means you need to be able to find each location quickly in relation to other known locations. Street addresses are a form of relative location, as are landmarks such as important buildings.



Since your partner wants to get an early start in the morning, you are going to arrive the night before. That means you need to begin at your hotel and then find the directions to the first stop on the itinerary, then from the first stop to the second stop, and so on. Be sure to write simple and easy-to-read directions. You need to be able to understand them quickly and under the pressure of getting from one place to another in a hurry.

There are different ways you can find out where each address on the <u>itinerary</u> is located. You could get a map of the city and plot each location. However, there are other tools that can give you relative directions quickly and easily. **Use the link below and follow the instructions to find driving directions** from one location to another. Notice that you can use the "print" button to provide easy to-co directions.

You will be using the ltinerary to
