#### **Guidelines for Student Participation in Discussions**

- Do more than agree or disagree. Justify and support your position with evidence.
- Prepare before participating. Read the assignment or lesson material to familiarize yourself with the topic. Think through your position and supporting evidence.
- · Respect others' opinions.
- · Read before you send!
- · Abide by Netiquette rules. Use proper grammar and punctuation.
- · Avoid slang, profanity, or potentially offensive language.
- · Be courteous when offering feedback to a fellow student.
- · Be gracious when receiving feedback from another student.
- · Use students' names when responding to their postings.

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When you support or agree with what someone is saying, you may want to use these response starters:

You may need to have something clarified that you "heard" another person say. Try using these starters:

#### Agree / Disagree

There are times when you may agree with only part of what someone is saying. You can use these starters to help you clarify not only what you agree with, but also what you disagree with:



#### Disagree

It is all right to disagree, but be sure to point out why you do not see eye to eye:

- I understand what you are saying, but I disagree because...
- You do make a good point; however, I think there is more evidence to support my point.
   Let me explain further...
- Your argument is well stated, but there is a problem with your evidence. Let me explain...
- I think we are going to have to agree to disagree here. I do not think I will convince you
  and you are not going to convince me, but I think we both stated our points well.



# How will I be graded?

#### **Online Discussion Grading Rubric**

#### 90-100%

- Displays an outstanding understanding of the specific content of the question or comment under discussion.
- Demonstrates superior writing quality/organization.
- Demonstrates expertise in the topic being discussed which might include use of appropriate terminology, references to specific material covered in the lesson, use of specific citations with supporting research/information, etc.
- Displays a respectful tone.
- Provides significant, quality responses to other students, perpetuating, but does not dominate the conversation.

#### 80-89%

- Displays an excellent to good understanding of the specific content of the question or comment under discussion. The writing quality is very good but not as organized or clear as an "A."
- Demonstrates knowledge in the topic being discussed which might include use of specific citations with supporting research/information, etc. Less evidence is provided than in an "A" participation.
- · Displays a respectful tone.
- Provides some quality responses to other students, perpetuating but does not dominate the conversation.

#### 70-79%

- Displays a good understanding of the specific content of the question or comment under discussion.
- The writing is acceptable and understandable.
- Attempts to support opinions including references to the lesson material.
- Displays an acceptable tone.
- Attempts to provide quality responses to the students, perpetuating, but does not dominate the conversation.

#### 60-69%

- Displays some understanding of the specific content of the question or comment under discussion.
- Communicates general thought, but writing lacks organization and clarity.
- Opinions are not well supported. There is little or no reference to lesson material.
- May display a questionable tone.
- Provides few, if any, quality responses to other students. The student does not seek to perpetuate the conversation.

#### 50-59%

- Displays a questionable or inadequate understanding of the specific content of the questions or comment under discussion.
- · Communicates poorly.
- Support opinions with no evidence.
- Displays questionable or unacceptable tone.
- . Does not respond to the postings of other students.
