One of the ways reporters gather information is to ask questions. Gathering information from people by asking questions can give us an idea of how people feel about issues. For the next few days, you are going to conduct a survey and examine the results so that you can report the findings. Later you will be asked to determine if you agree with the participants of your survey. The issues that affect your life. By discussing what some people think about the important issues, you will begin thinking about which of those you find important and would like to study further.

- ❖ There are many survey sites that are easy to use but we like you to use zoomerang.com. This site allows you to create a report and send the link to your teacher in the assessment without needing login information.
- ❖ Many students want to use SurveyMonkey.com because it is so easy, however, there is no way to generate a live report for your assessment. Therefore, do not use SurveyMonkey. The final link for your assessment needs to lead to a report of your responses. Zoomerang will provide that. If you find another site that does provide a report please let me know so I can check it out!



Report Analysis

- ❖ Once you click the “Analyze Results” tab, look at your survey report and analyze the data.
- ❖ There will be issues that people most strongly agreed with and others they most strongly disagreed with. Start to think about why they may have chose these responses. Are the opinions given by your respondents different than yours? Do you think the demographics (age, sex, profession, location, etc.) had anything to do with the results? Do you think that changing any of these factors would make a difference?
- ❖ Take notes on your observations and thoughts of your responses.
